Please include information about arrival and departure, need for accommodation, meals and travel arrangements (car, train, flight)!

The **Attendance Fee** for pupils and students (with a valid identification card) amounts to € 35,- per person and includes the lunch and dinner at Saturday as well as the accommodation / breakfast from Friday to Sunday in a double bedroom (***)L Hotel Dresden Altstadt, www.leonardo-hotels.de) as long as you sign up before 02.10.2010. For a single room the extra amount is € 25,-. The Attendance Fee for everyone else amounts to € 50,- per person including the same conditions mentioned above.

For any registration from the 02.10.2010 on the Attendance Fee for any participant amounts to € 70,- for a double bedroom (again additionally € 25,- for a single bedroom). If you decide to arrive on Thursday already there will be an additional Attendance Fee of € 38,- for a double bedroom or € 58,- for a single bedroom including the entrance fee to the Radeberger Brauerei (visit to the Radeberger Brewery). Attendants not staying overnight have to pay an Attendance Fee of € 10,- per day (Thursday, Friday, Saturday), attendance on Sunday is free of charge.

Guests from Middle and Eastern Europe are freed from the Attendance Fee and can request a travelling allowance with the coupon for registration. A prior consultation with the office in Munich is **mandatory** for receiving the allowance, otherwise there will be no refund. **No** confirmations for participation will be sent out!

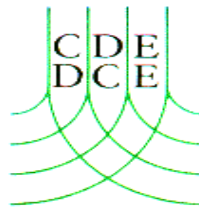
